This funding will be used to:

Ensure that every student, every day is succeeding at Aratula State School.

The indicators are:

- 85% of students achieving in the upper two bands for Reading, Writing and Numeracy in Year 3 and Year 5.
- 100% of students above the National Minimum Standards.
- Increase the number of students achieving a C standard or higher across all year levels.

Our initiatives include:

- Early Start Program to inform and monitor student progress.
- Individual learning goals for literacy, writing and numeracy for all students.
- Embedded reading framework that promotes higher order thinking.
- Targeted verbal feedback to support student improvement.
- Targeted literacy and numeracy programs for students at risk.

Aratula State School will improve student outcomes by:

- Provide additional trained teacher aide time to deliver tailored learning programs and small group instruction in all classes. This will support teachers with improving academic outcomes for all students. Funding \$5974
- Release classroom teachers to work collaboratively to analyse students' data, plan individual student programs and participate in professional learning activities. This will occur in term 1,2,3 and 4. Funding \$7000
- Provide strategic support to identified students through individualised specialist teaching sessions. Funding \$12 000
