Ensure that every student is succeeding. Our success indicators are:

- 50% of students achieving in the upper two bands for Reading in Year 3 and Year 5.
- 25% of students achieving in the upper two bands for Writing in Year 3 and Year 5.
- 100% of students above national minimum standard for writing.
- Achieve a relative gain at or above national levels for all students in Year 3 and Year 5 in reading and writing.
- Increasing the number of students achieving a C standard or better in Year 3 English from 60% in 2017 to 80% in 2018.
- Increasing the number of students achieving a C standard or better in Year 5 English from 67% in 2017 to 80% in 2018.

Our initiatives include


- Embedded reading framework that promotes higher order thinking.
- Targeted literacy and numeracy programs for students at risk of falling below national minimum standard.
- Individual learning goals for reading and writing for all students with regular written and verbal feedback to support continuous improvement.
- Use Early Start materials from Prep to Year 2 to inform teaching and monitor progress.
- Participate in the *Getting Kids Writing: One Sentence at a Time* intervention project to improve writing for all students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Purchasing additional teacher time, releasing classroom teachers to work collaboratively to analyse student data, plan individualised programs of instruction and participate in professional learning activities one day per term (Term 1, 2 and 3).	\$3,875
Providing an additional highly skilled full-time teacher aide to deliver tailored learning programs and small group instruction in all classes. This will support teachers to improve academic outcomes for all students.	\$19,117
