Ensure that every student is succeeding. Our success indicators are:

- 100% of students above national minimum standard in Reading
- 100% of students above national minimum standard in Writing
- 50% of students achieving in the upper two bands for Reading in Year 3 and Year 5
- Relative gain at or above national levels for all students in Year 3 and Year 5 in reading, writing and numeracy.

Our initiatives include

- Embedded reading framework that promotes higher order thinking.
- Intense teacher support for students at risk of falling below national minimum standard.
- Targeted literacy and numeracy extension programs.
- Develop a shared understanding of 'data literacy' and support teachers and leadership teams to effectively use data to inform targeted teaching
- use Early Start materials across Prep to Year 2 to inform teaching, learning and resourcing, and to track progress
- Develop a fabrication laboratory to develop students emerging digital literacy
